Rich Delmar retired at the end of 2024 after 47 years of military and civilian service in the Navy JAG Corps, the Department of Justice, and the Department of the Treasury. His military duties included court-martial appeals, administrative discharge reviews, and service with the Naval Inspector General.

In his civilian career, he worked in tax litigation and enforcement and in Treasury program evaluation and oversight as Counsel to the Treasury Inspector General, culminating with five years as the Acting Inspector General.
