

Geoff DeWeese spent twenty-nine years in the Army as an enlisted paralegal and a commissioned judge advocate, on active duty and in the reserves. He retired as a lieutenant colonel in March 2025.

His diverse assignments include legal assistance, administrative law, operational law and trial counsel, 1st Armored Division in Germany, defense counsel and senior defense counsel, Army Trial Defense Services in Alaska and Washington, group judge advocate for the 4th Psychological Operations Group (Airborne), chief of military justice with Army Central Command; chief of cyberspace operational Law and deputy chief of International and operational law, U.S. Strategic Command, senior defense counsel and command judge advocate in the reserves, senior legal advisor at U.S. Central Command, and defense counsel and deputy general counsel with the Military Commissions Defense Organization in Washington DC and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Geoff also spent time as a deputy district attorney and private defense counsel in his home state of Colorado.
